Our Unit of Inquiry:

Theme: Where we are in time and place
Central Idea: Significant events and people shape our lives.

The lines of inquiry we will explore are:

- How a significant event leads to improvement
- How significant people contribute towards achievement
- The impact of events and individuals from the past on life today



Our key text we will be reading: Vlad and the Great Fire of London

Writing:

- Diary entry The Great Fire of London
- Poetry sensory poems

Science unit: Living things and their habitats - life processes, habitats and food chains

Maths:

- recognise the place value of each digit in a two-digit number (tens, ones)
- identify, represent and estimate numbers using different representations, including the number line
- read and write numbers to at least 100 in numerals and in words
- solve problems with addition and subtraction:
- recall and use addition and subtraction facts to 20 fluently, and derive and use related facts up to 100
- recognise and use the inverse relationship between addition and subtraction

PE: Please remember that PE will be on Tuesdays and Thursdays this term. Children will need indoor, and outdoor kits - and will be outside weather dependent.

Home learning:

Please remember to practise spellings and Maths Champion targets with your children.
