We hope that you all had a wonderful Christmas and enjoyed spending time with your family. We have an exciting module of new learning ahead!

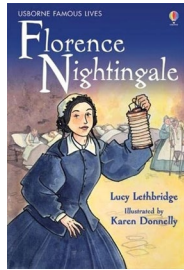
Our Unit of Inquiry:

Theme: **How we organise ourselves**

Central Idea: **The lives of pioneering people affect society today.**

The lines of inquiry we will explore are:

- The lives of Florence Nightingale and Mary Seacole
- How pioneering people's work can cause change.
- How I can make a difference



Our key texts we will be reading : The Extraordinary Life of Mary Seacole, Big People Little Dream's Florence Nightingale, Florence Nightingale by Lucy Lethbridge

Writing: Persuasive Letters to change the Victorian hospitals, explanation texts and factfiles.

Science unit : Animals including humans - the needs of animals for survival.

Maths:

- Recognise and use symbols for pounds (£) and pence (p); combine amounts to make a particular value
- Calculate mathematical statements for multiplication and division within the times tables and write them using signs - multiplication (\times), division (\div) and equals (=)
- Show that multiplication of two numbers can be done in any order (commutative) and division of one number by another cannot
- Recall and use multiplication and division facts for the 2, 5 and 10 multiplication tables, including recognising odd and even numbers

PE: Please remember that PE will be on Tuesdays and Thursdays this term. Children will need indoor, and outdoor kits - and will be outside weather dependent.

Home learning:

Please remember to practise spellings and Maths Champion targets with your children.

Reading: Children are expected to read at home for pleasure at least three times a week. The page numbers need to be recorded in their reading records three times.

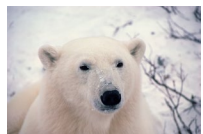
