Our Module 4 Unit of Inquiry:

Theme: **How the world works**

Central Idea: **Technology affects the ways we travel and connect with one another.**



The lines of inquiry we will explore are:

- How transport has changed over time
- How technology has changed the way we connect with one another
- How technology has influenced art

Our key texts we will be reading : Journey, by Aaron Becker, Mrs Armitage on Wheels, by Quentin Blake

Writing: Narrative - diary entry, springtime shape poem

Science unit : Plants - wild and garden plants, evergreen and deciduous trees



Maths:

- Place value - counting from 20 - 50
- Counting in 10s, grouping 10s and 1s
- The number line to 50 - estimating numbers on a number line
- Length and height - comparing lengths and heights
- Measure length using objects and centimetres
- Mass and volume
- Heavier and lighter
- Measure and compare mass
- Full and empty
- Measure and compare capacity

PE: Please remember that PE will be on Wednesdays and Thursdays this term. Children will need indoor, and outdoor kits - and will be outside weather dependent.

Home learning:

Please remember to practise spellings and Maths Champion targets with your children.
