Enjoy our photos from Module 3. We enjoyed Year 6 Computing Day, Numbers Day and sharing books with our year 3 reading buddies!

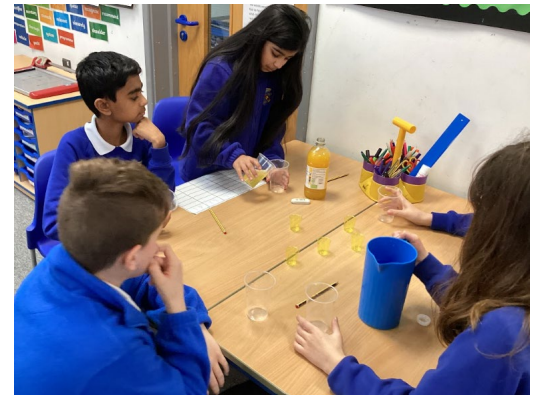
In Module 3 our Unit of Inquiry was:
